- **New for 2018-2019** ~ All entries in the TFMC Angie Greer Music in Poetry Contest must be submitted **electronically**, as MS Word documents, by **January 1, 2019**. Printed copies sent by postal mail will **NOT** be accepted.
- The poem must be the original, unpublished work of the entrant, and only one poem per person may be submitted.
- The entrant (applicant) must not have reached the age of 19 by February 1, 2019.
- Previous winners of the TFMC "Music in Poetry" Contest, who did not win the Regional award, are eligible to re-enter the state contest after one year.
- Entrants must be American citizens by birth or naturalization, Junior Music Club members of the TFMC Junior Division, and their teachers must be TFMC Senior Club members.
- The poem must have a musically-themed title and content related to music.
- Entries must be typed in a black font on a white page (as an MS Word document), with the title, the entrant's name and address typed at the top of the page.
- The poem may be in any form, with or without rhyme, no shorter than 8 lines and no longer than 30 lines.
- Judging will be based upon originality, creativity and relationship to music.
- There is **NO** entry fee for the TFMC State "Music in Poetry" Contest.
- Submit the poem and completed application form by e-mail no later than January 1, 2019.
- Tennessee's winners (and their Junior Counselors) will be notified by e-mail on or before January 15, 2019, and given instructions on how to enter the NFMC (National) Contest for the Southeastern Region Award.
- All entrants will receive certificates.
